FASOTRAGRUPAC INSTRUCTION 3440.1G

SUBJ: FASOTRAGRUPAC EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN (EMP)

Ref: (a) NASNIINST 3440.4C ("Emergency Management Plan (EMP)"
Short Title NASNI EMP 1-91)

1. Purpose. To establish an Emergency Management Plan in support of reference (a).
2. Cancellation. FASOTRAGRUPAC Instruction 3440.1F
3. Background. Reference (a) is a complete and comprehensive plan that outlines emergency management organization, intelligence, operations, logistics, personnel, public affairs, civil affairs, environmental services, command relationships, communications, mapping/charting, training/exercise, dispersal/evacuation, reports, readiness conditions/alerting systems, legal, humanitarian services, joint key asset protection/land defense of CONUS (JKAP/LDC). The plan is directed toward minimizing loss of life and property damage, protection of personnel, property and functions, and restoration of command and control and continuation of essential functions and operations in support of operating military forces.
4. Objectives
 - a. When contacted, render all possible assistance to the NAS North Island Emergency Management Coordinator.
 - b. Minimize casualties.
 - c. Maintain maximum readiness.
 - d. Organize personnel and material assets as directed by reference (a).
5. Responsibilities
 - a. Officers in Charge, detachments will ensure compliance with local disaster preparedness directives.
 - b. Officer of the Day

FASOTRAGRUPACINST 3440.1G

28 DEC 1992

(1) When communication with NAS North Island Emergency Management Coordinator has been established, contact the FASO Emergency Management Representative (Disaster Preparedness Officer), XO and CO.

(2) Inform the DPO, XO, and CO of the imminence and type danger expected. Keep them informed of all pertinent information.

(3) Place recall bill in alert, if necessary.

c. Disaster Preparedness Officer

(1) Maintain liaison with the FASOTRAGRUPAC OOD and NAS North Island Emergency Management Coordinator.

(2) Upon direction, supervise the organization and training of basic teams required for immediate response.

(3) Upon direction, conduct emergency management plan drills.

(4) Provide division officers with further team assignment requirements after coordinating with NASNI Emergency Management Coordinator.

d. Department Heads

(1) Prevent panic and maintain morale (dispel rumors).

(2) Report damage and casualty conditions to the FASOTRAGRUPAC OOD.

6. General. Reference (a) provides in-depth guidance regarding signals/shelters and info pertinent to Emergency Management Plan. All hands will comply as directed.
